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TERMS OF REFERENCE

PROVISION OF OFFICE ACCOMODATION TO MICT SETA CAPE TOWN REGIONAL OFFICE FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS.



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1. BACKGROUND

MICT SETA, one of the Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETA's), was established in March 2000 to transform the skills profile of the Media, Information and Communications Technology (MICT) sector. It operates within the context of the National Skills Development Plan to raise the levels, quality and relevance of the education and training in the sector and encourages partnerships between the public and private organisations to benefit employers, employees and the unemployed.

2. OBJECTIVE

MICT SETA seeks to find a suitable service provider within the Cape Town area for office accommodation for a period of three (3) years.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The proposal submitted by bidders must include the following MICT SETA requirements and MICT SETA will not incur any fit out costs:

3.1 Building- General Requirements

- 3.1.1. The office space must be in the Cape Town area or within a 2km radius from the CBD.
- 3.1.2. Close proximity to public transportation.
- 3.1.3. The actual building size proposed must be between a range of 300-400m².
- 3.1.4. Proposals must be submitted according to the Grade of the building.
- 3.1.5. The building should allow for comfortable entrance / exit to and from the building by staff, clients and service providers.
- 3.1.6. The building and office space must make provision for access control which must be accessible to both staff and stakeholders.
- 3.1.7. The building should have access for people with special needs/ disability (e.g. wheel chair ramp).
- 3.1.8. The building must be an existing building (complete built structure).
- 3.1.9. B or C Grade office accommodation.
- 3.1.10. Approximately 300-400m² Gross Lettable Area (GLA).
- 3.1.11. Exterior signage must be allowable.
- 3.1.12. Building insurance is the responsibility of the landlord.
- 3.1.13. A building with a green rating would be advantageous
- 3.1.14. Minimum of seven (7) Secure on-site parking and sufficient parking for visitors parking, must be available for visitors and stakeholders.
- 3.1.15. Provision of a boardroom with a 20 seater capacity.
- 3.1.16. Provision of three (3) offices, two (2) meeting rooms, a kitchen, sick bay and an open plan with six (6) Working stations.
- 3.1.17. 24-hour security with surveillance cameras and controlled access to the offices.



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3.2. Building Services

- 3.2.1. The building must make provision for goods and passengers lifts (if applicable)
- 3.2.2. Ablution facilities accommodating approximately seven (7) people and visitors, including facilities for the physically disabled.
- 3.2.3. The accommodation must provide lighting as per building regulations.
- 3.2.4. The office accommodation must be fully air-conditioned and ventilated.
- 3.2.5. Uninterrupted power supply (UPS) and back-up generator power supply must be available in the event of power failure for the entire building.
- 3.2.6. The space(s) on offer must have its own electric distribution board(s).
- 3.2.7. The accommodation must have existing fire detection and prevention services.
- 3.2.8. A floor plan of the building drawn to scale is required.
- 3.2.9. Provision of one (1) storeroom.
- 3.2.10. The lease offered must be for 36 months. The lease offered must also allow for further extension of the building if required which will mainly cater for ablution and office space.
- 3.8.11. The lease offered must provide a termination option.
- 3.8.12. The lease offered must provide the MICT SETA with right of first refusal.
- 3.8.13. The lease offered must indicate the tenant installation allowance.
- 3.8.14. The lease offered must provide an option for building maintenance by the lessor / landlord as part of the lease.
- 3.8.15. The lease contract should be signed with the owner of the building/ landlord not an agency or third party.

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA

4. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Bids received will be evaluated against the following set evaluation criteria.

4.1. PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (Regulation 4)

Bidder shall submit their BBBEE status, EME, QSE or generic.

Proof of compliance

Bidder must submit a valid proof of BBBEE status (BBBEE verification certificate issued by a SANAS accredited agency verification agency or CIPC B-BBEE certificate or B-BBEE affidavit duly sworn and commissioned.

4.2. MANDATORY CRITERIA

Bidder must own the property / building or has the sole rights to rent out as an agent.

Proof of compliance

If the bidder is the owner of the property /building, a documented proof indicating ownership of the specified building must be submitted, or

If the bidder has the sole rights to rent out as an agent, a documented proof or memorandum of agreement for the specified building must be submitted.

Note: Bidders that do not meet the requirements of set pre-qualification and mandatory criteria will be eliminated from further evaluation process.

4.3. FUNCTIONAL CRITERIA

4.3.1. Technical Evaluation

Only bidders that have met the set pre-qualification and mandatory criteria will be considered for functionality evaluation.

The RFB submission will be technically evaluated out of a maximum of **100 points**. A threshold of **70** out of the **100 points** has been set. Only bidders that have met or exceeded the minimum threshold of **70** points for functionality will be evaluated and scored in terms of price and B-BBEE.

Note: All bidders achieving less than the set threshold will be declared non-responsive. Assessment of evaluation of the functional/ technical criteria will be based on the table below.

NB!! Site inspection might be conducted for the first three (3) bidders with the highest points on functional criteria.

PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEM

4.4. PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEM

- a. The bidder obtaining the highest number of total points will be awarded the contract unless objective criteria justify the award to another bidder.
- b. In the event that two or more tenderers have scored equal total points, the successful tenderer must be the one that scored the highest points for B-BBEE.
- c. If two or more tenderers have equal points, including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful tenderer must be the one scoring the highest score for functionality, if functionality is part of the evaluation process.
- d. In the event that two or more tenderers are equal in all respects, the award must be decided by the drawing of lots

4.4.1 POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

Maximum 80 points for price will be allocated as per paragraph 3.1 of Preferential Procurement Regulations 2011, refer to Preferential Procurement Claim form on **SBD 6.1**.

4.4.2 POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE

Maximum 20 points for B-BBEE will be allocated as per paragraph 4.1 of Preferential Procurement Regulations 2011, refer to Preferential Procurement Claim form on **SBD 6.1**.

- a. Bidders who qualify as EME's and QSE's in terms of the B-BBEE Act must submit a Sworn affidavit. Misrepresentation of information, constitutes a criminal offence.
- b. Bidders other than EME's or QSE's must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by SANAS.
- c. A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits their B-BBEE status level certificate.
- d. A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.
- e. Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialized scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- f. A Bidder will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the bid documents that such a bidder intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a bidder qualifies for, unless the intended Sub-contractor is an EME that has the capacity and the ability to execute the sub-contract.
- g. A Bidder awarded a contract may not sub-contract more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is sub-contracted to an EME that has the capacity and the ability to execute the sub-contract.

2 DEFINITIONS

- (c) "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of goods or services, through price Bid, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals;
- (d) "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
