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TERMS OF REFERENCE

APPOINTMENT OF A SERVICE PROVIDER FOR PROVISION OF OFFICE ACCOMODATION TO MICT SETA DURBAN REGIONAL OFFICE FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS.



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BACKGROUND

MICT SETA, one of the Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETA's), was established in March 2000 to transform the skills profile of the Media, Information and Communications Technology (MICT) sector. It operates within the context of the National Skills Development Plan to raise the levels, quality and relevance of the education and training in the sector and encourages partnerships between the public and private organisations to benefit employers, employees and the unemployed.

2. OBJECTIVE

MICT SETA seeks to find a suitable service provider within the Durban area for office accommodation for a period of three (3) years.

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The proposal submitted by bidders must include the following MICT SETA requirements and MICT SETA will not incur any fit out costs:

3.1 Building- General Requirements

- 3.1.1. The office space within an office park or a stand-alone building must be in the Durban area or within a 10km radius from the CBD.
- 3.1.2. Close proximity to public transportation.
- 3.1.3. The actual building size proposed must be between a range of 300-400m².
- 3.1.4. Proposals must be submitted according to the Grade of the building.
- 3.1.5. The building should allow for comfortable entrance / exit to and from the building by staff, clients and service providers.
- 3.1.6. The building and office space must make provision for access control which must be accessible to both staff and stakeholders.
- 3.1.7. The building should have access for people with special needs/ disability (e.g. wheel chair ramp).
- 3.1.8. The building must be an existing building (complete built structure) within a complex of other offices/ business.
- 3.1.9. B or C Grade office accommodation.
- 3.1.10. Approximately 300-400m² Gross Lettable Area (GLA).
- 3.1.11. Exterior signage must be allowable.
- 3.1.12. Building insurance is the responsibility of the landlord.
- 3.1.13. A building with a green rating would be advantageous
- 3.1.14. Minimum of ten (10) Secure on-site parking for staff and sufficient parking for visitors, and stakeholders.

must be available for visitors and stakeholders.

- 3.1.15. Provision of a boardroom and a mini boardroom within the parameters of the rental space (300-400 sqm)
- 3.1.16. Provision for two (2) meeting rooms, an open area kitchen space and eating area, sick bay, provision for (2) two storeroom and printing area. There must be a strong (server) room, in addition to the storeroom. Only managers will have offices (glass cubicles) and the rest of the staff have open plan area. Currently there is one (1) Manager.
- 3.1.17. The service provider must supply workstations that allow for sitting of 6 people, the furniture must consist of 6 chairs, lockable credenza and the working station cubicle at least 90cm high from the workable/ table area. The working station must cater for covid-19 social distancing of 1,5m. The provision for of the furniture should be provided as rental cost to MICT SETA.



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- 3.1.18. General safely within the complex: An outside surveillance cameras and controlled access an active alarm system, etc.
- 3.1.19. The bidder will be required to provide office layout plans.
- 3.1.20. The landlord must provide the open plan workstations furniture and also paint wherever required using the MICT SETA colours.
- 3.1.21. The open plan arrangement should have power points.

3.2. Building Services

- 3.2.1. The building must make provision for goods and passengers lifts (if applicable)
- 3.2.2. Ablution facilities accommodating approximately seven (7) people and visitors, including facilities for the physically disabled.
- 3.2.3. The accommodation must provide lighting as per building regulations.
- 3.2.4. The office accommodation must be fully air-conditioned and ventilated.
- 3.2.5. Uninterrupted power supply (UPS) and back-up generator power supply must be available in the event of power failure for the entire building.
- 3.2.6. The space(s) on offer must have its own electric distribution board(s).
- 3.2.7. The accommodation must have existing fire detection and prevention services.
- 3.2.8. A floor plan of the building drawn to scale with a detailed entrance and exits routes.
- 3.2.9. Provision of one (1) storeroom.
- 3.2.10. The lease offered must be for 36 months. The lease offered must also allow for further extension of the building if required which will mainly cater for ablution and office space.
- 3.8.11. The lease offered must provide a termination option.
- 3.8.12. The lease offered must provide the MICT SETA with right of first refusal.
- 3.8.13. The lease offered must indicate the tenant installation requirements.
- 3.8.14. The lease offered must provide an option for building maintenance by the lessor / landlord as part of the lease.
- 3.8.15. The lease contract should be signed with the owner of the building/landlord not an agency or third party.

Note: The successful bidder will be responsible for the cost of alterations necessary to adapt to the offered accommodation to the specific needs of MICT SETA in accordance with the norm document and/or specified minimum requirements.

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA

4. EVALUATION CRITERIA

Bids received will be evaluated against the following set evaluation criteria.

4.1. PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA (Regulation 4)-PPPFA

a) Bidder shall have a minimum BBBEE status of level 3 or better.

Proof of compliance

Bidder must submit a valid proof of BBBEE status (BBBEE verification certificate issued by a SANAS accredited agency verification agency or CIPC B-BBEE certificate or B-BBEE affidavit duly sworn and commissioned).

Bidders please take note:

The duly sworn and commissioned BBBEE affidavits must be based on the Audited Financial Statements/Financial Statements and other information available on the latest financial year-end DD/MM/YYYY. 4.2. MANDATORY CRITERIA

4.3. FUNCTIONAL CRITERIA

4.3.1. Technical Evaluation

Only bidders that have met the set pre-qualification and mandatory criteria will be considered for functionality evaluation. The bids submitted will be technically evaluated out of a maximum of **100 points**. A threshold of **70** out of the **100 points** has been set.

Only bidders that have met or exceeded the minimum threshold on technical functionality of **70** points will qualify for further evaluation on Price and B-BBEE according to the 80/20 preference point system in terms of the PPPFA Regulations 2017, where 80 points will be for Price and 20 points will be for B-BBEE status level of contribution.

NB!! Site inspection will be conducted for the bidder/s with the highest points on functional criteria.

Note: All bidders achieving less than the set threshold of 70 out of the 100 points will be declared non-responsive.
