1. BACKGROUND

The Media, Information and Communication Technologies Sector Education and Training Authority (MICT SETA) is a public entity established in terms of Section 9(1) of the Skills Development Act (Act No. 97 of 1998). The MICT SETA plays a pivotal role in achieving South Africa's skills development and economic growth within the 5 distinct sub-sectors it operates in; i.e. Advertising, Film and Electronic Media, Electronics, Information Technology, and Telecommunications.

The MICT SETA intents to modernise its value chain by introducing technology solutions that improve management and processing of its data and information in an efficient and effective manner, provide instant and accurate reporting and reduce manual processes in its value chain. The lack of adequate infrastructure has a negative effect on the organisation's ability to provide specific focused services in line with its Value on customer centricity.

In line with the vision of the MICT SETA of "a global leader in the development and delivery of revolutionary ICT skills", the MICT SETA seeks to refresh its computing equipment and peripherals that will enable its workforce to service its stakeholders diligently.

The MICT SETA is looking to appoint a panel of suitably qualified, experienced, and accredited service providers for the provision and supply of its computing equipment and peripherals for a period of thirty-six (36) months. The project should address the above challenges and enable the organisation to achieve project objectives as detailed herein under.

2. PURPOSE

To invite service providers with the necessary expertise, experience, and accreditation to submit proposals to serve as a panel for the provision and supply of new computing equipment for a period of thirty-six (36) months.

3. OBJECTIVES

The following were identified as objectives:
