TERMS OF REFERENCE

1. INTRODUCTION

The Media, Information and Communication Technologies Sector Education and Training Authority (MICT SETA) is a public entity established in terms of Section 9(1) of the Skills Development Act (Act No. 97 of 1998). The MICT SETA plays a pivotal role in achieving South Africa's skills development and economic growth within the 5 distinct sub-sectors it operates in, i.e., Advertising, Film and Electronic Media, Electronics, Information Technology, and Telecommunications.

2. BACKGROUND

The MICT SETA intends to modernise its value chain by introducing technology solutions that improve management and processing of its data and information in an efficient and effective manner; provide instant and accurate reporting and reduce manual processes in its value chain.

In line with the vision of the MICT SETA of "cutting-edge future skills", the MICT SETA seeks install resilient physical security systems to avoid serious loss or damage to the organisation. The existing access control system is not fully operational, and there are no CCTV cameras in place.

3. PURPOSE

MICT SETA seeks to appoint a service provider with the necessary expertise and experience to install and provide **3-year** support and maintenance of the latest **cloud-based** access control and CCTV system within the Midrand Head Office.

4. OBJECTIVES

The following were identified as objectives:

- 4.1. discourage potential intruders;
- 4.2. delay or outright deny attempts to intruders;
- 4.3. stopping of incidents before they ever occur;
- 4.4. ensure access to restricted areas is relegated to authorized personnel only.

5. SCOPE AND REQUIREMENTS

The successful service provider will be required to provide and implement the following:

5.1 Access Control

MICT SETA requires touchless readers. The readers must be configured to allow the use of facial, palm and/or a smartphone linked with a unique QR code to access the building or open doors.

- 5.2.1. install access control to the building entrances;
- 5.2.2. Install access control to the server room and switch room;
- 5.2.3. install access control to the CEO's office;
- 5.2.4. install access control to the canteen and passage door;
- 5.2.5. install access control and maglocks to the doors that links the level 2 and level 3 floor;
- 5.2.6. install a maglock to the switch room;
- 5.2.7. Install standby battery / UPS for the two main access doors;
- 5.2.8. install standby battery / UPS for the two doors that links the level 2 and level 3 floor.

5.2 CCTV

- 5.2.1. Install 2 x cameras at the reception area;
- 5.2.2. install camera at the entrance of level 2 floor;
- 5.2.3. install 4 x cameras at the passage of the level 2 floor;

6. INSTALLATION

- 6.1. It is expected that this specification will allow the Service Provider to scope and implement a complete and working physical security system. Should there be unclear or incomprehensive requirement; the bidder can seek further clarity at the Compulsory Briefing Session.
- 6.2. The proposed solution must be completely isolated from MICT SETA Local Area Network.
- 6.3. The successful service provider will be required to ensure that all cabling is clearly marked and labelled.
- 6.4. All required cables, software and accessories that make up the proposed solution must be included as part of the proposal.
- 6.5. All cabling must be done neat to ensure a safe and clean environment. No cables are to be present on the floor nor must they be found to be easily snagged or pulled.
- 6.6. The successful service provider will be required to carry out all installations, documentation, and handover to MICT SETA.
- 6.7. The successful service provider will be required to provide training to MICT SETA officials.

7. MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT

- 7.1. The Service Provider is obliged to, as part of procuring the equipment and software, procure such in MICT SETA's name, with the necessary Support and Maintenance.
- 7.2. The Service Provider will be required to, as part of the deployment procured through this Acquisition exercise, provide support and maintenance for a period of 3 years.
