#### 1. INTRODUCTION AND BACKGROUND

The MICT SETA seeks to **hire** a seamless LED display screen for our Annual General Meeting (AGM), scheduled to take place in **Cape Town** on **Friday 27 October 2023**. This is a corporate event attended by our constituent stakeholders in the media and ICT sector and other dignitaries.

The stage dimensions are  $6m \times 3m$ . The appointed service provider will be responsible for delivering exceptional services in accordance with the scope of work, ensuring the adherence to the MICT SETA's brand guidelines and image.

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK

The appointed service provider will be expected to perform the following services as duties and responsibilities:
