## CALL FOR THREE (3) INDEPENDENT MEMBERS TO SERVE AS A CHAIRPERSON (1) AND MEMBERS OF THE AUDIT AND RISK COMMITTEE (2) FOR A FIVE (5) YEAR PERIOD (COMMENCING 1 OCTOBER 2025)

The MICT SETA is a Schedule 3A public entity, established by the Minister of Higher Education and Training. The SETA is governed by the Skills Development Act 97 of 1998, the Public Finance Management Act 1 of 1999, the National Treasury Regulations, SETA Constitution and other relevant laws. The MICT SETA subscribes to the principles of the King IV Code of Corporate Governance, 2016.

MICT SETA is calling for applications from professionals who wish to serve as Independent Audit and Risk Committee members for a period of five (5) years. Applicants must have post graduate qualifications in either Audit (internal) and external, Technology and Information Governance, Law, Risk Management and Governance. The ARC is a statutory Committee and candidates are expected to have advanced understanding of the fiduciary duties as outlined in the Public Finance Management Act, the Companies Act, 2008 (Act 71 of 2008) and King IV on Corporate Governance.

Suitable candidates should meet the following minimum requirements: • Must have exposure of a minimum of 5 years serving as an Audit Committee Member or Chairperson in the public sector environment • Relevant degree or equivalent qualification in Accounting, Auditing, Technology and Information Governance, Law, Risk Management and Governance • Proven expertise and experience in the fields of financial management, risk management, internal auditing, legal, technology and information governance and corporate governance • Proven knowledge and experience in a SETA Environment will be advantageous • Registration with the South African Institute of Chartered Accountants (SAICA) will be advantageous.

Applicants with foreign qualifications must be evaluated by the South African Qualification Authority (SAQA) and relevant report must be submitted with the application. It is the applicant's responsibility to have foreign qualifications evaluated by the SAQA. Successful applicants will be required to undergo appropriate background checks. Correspondence will be limited only to the shortlisted applicants.

Interested applicants must submit an application letter, detailed Curriculum Vitae, certified copies of academic qualifications and Identity Document (not older than 3 months) to <u>2025boardnominations@mict.org.za</u>
