REQUIREMENT DESCRIPTION: APPOINTMENT OF A RECYCLING SERVICE PROVIDER TO DISPOSE THE MICT SETA REDUNDANT ICT ASSETS

1. INTRODUCTION

The Media, Information and Communication Technologies Sector Education and Training Authority ("MICT SETA") is established in terms of section 9(1) of the Skills Development Act, 1998 (Act No. 97 of 1998), and is responsible for achieving South Africa's skills development and economic growth within the following five sub-sectors: advertising, film and electronic media, electronics, information technology and telecommunications.

2. PURPOSE

The MICT SETA intends to appoint a credible service provider to conduct secure disposal and recycling of its ICT equipment in an appropriate and environmentally friendly manner. The appointment of an ICT disposal/recycling service provider will ensure that the disposal of the MICT SETA ICT assets comply with the necessary legal requirements under environmental and data laws. See detailed list of these ICT Assets in annexure "A".

3. SCOPE OF WORK

The Successful bidders will be responsible for the below-mentioned scope of works but not limited to:

- 3.1. Provide collection and transportation service of assets at MICT SETA (Head office).
- 3.2. The service provider is required to give MICT SETA an offer on these ICT assets as one lot.
- 3.3. The appointed service provider must provide the MICT SETA with a certificate of destruction to ensure that the disposal of the ICT assets complied with the environmental standards and regulations. Destruction certificate must be issued within five (5) working days post collection.
- 3.4 The appointed service provider will work with MICT SETA staff to compile a list of assets collected from the premises in order for MICT SETA to remove the assets from the asset register.
- 3.5. Awarded may be made to the service provider that will give a competitive / higher offer to MICT SETA.
- 3.6. Transaction should be at no cost to the MICT SETA.
- 3.7. The awarded service provider will be expected to remove the assets within ten (10) working days upon receipt of proof of payment.
- 3.9. Awarded bidder will provide MICT Seta with proof of payment to the MICT SETA account within Five days upon receipt of acceptance letter.

7. EVALUATION CRITERIA

MICT SETA complies with the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, Act No. 1 of 1999 as amended; Treasury Regulations of 2005; the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000; Preferential Procurement Regulations of 2022; and the MICT SETA Supply Chain Management (SCM) Policy.

RFO received will be evaluated on Mandatory requirements and highest price offer.

7.1 Stage 1– Mandatory Requirements

a) Compulsory site inspection

Compulsory site inspection will be part of the acquisition process for all participating Service Providers. Non-attendance will thereof automatically disqualify any prospective bidder.

Evidence required:

Signing of attendance Register of the Compulsory Site Inspection to be held on **18 February 2026 from 10:AM UNTIL 11:00AM**. Representatives are required to sign the attendance register and write name of the bidder, name of representative, and contact details on Compulsory site Inspection attendance register

b) Accreditation

Bidder must be accredited by the e-Waste Association of South Africa (eWASA) or the Institute of Waste Management of Southern Africa (IWMSA).

Evidence required:

The Bidder must submit a valid a copy Membership Certificate from the e-Waste Association of South Africa (eWASA) e-waste association of South Africa (EWASA) or the Institute of Waste Management of Southern Africa (IWMSA).

c) Experience

Bidders must have a 2 years experience in recycling Information Communication Technology equipment (ICT).

Evidence required:

The bidder must submit two (2) signed reference letters with contactable references indicating in recycling Information Communication Technology equipment (ICT)in the past ten (10) years. The reference letters must be from Bidder's clients, must be signed on clients' letterhead.

NOTE: BIDDERS THAT DO NOT MEET THE MANDATORY CRITERIA WILL BE ELIMINATED FROM FURTHER EVALUATION PROCESS.

8. STAGE 2: PRICE AND SPECIFIC GOALS

Only bidder/s or RFQ submissions that have met the requirements of evaluation criteria will qualify for further evaluation on Price and Specific Goals according to the 80/20 preference point system in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, where 80 points will be for Price and 20 points will be for Specific Goals. RFQ will be awarded to the bidder scoring the highest points.
